There are 5 **Women’s Initiative Committees** that Business Connectors have the opportunity to give your professional advice in areas such as finance, marketing, event planning, communications, and philanthropy.

There are 5 committees to join:

1. Loan Committee
2. Business Conference Leadership Council
3. Gala Leadership Council
4. Advisory Boards- Marin, Alameda, Silicon Valley, Contra Costa
5. Business Connector Committee

Business Connector’s Role

The role of a committee member varies on each committee. In general, the business connector is an advisory to the committee. They provide advice collectively. They contribute to the growth and support of Women’s Initiative. The business Connector increases resources for Women’s Initiative clients and organization overall.

Time Commitment

Varies based on committee.

1. Loan Committee- First Tuesday of each month for an hour.
2. Business Conference Leadership Council- Three plus hours for four months
3. Gala Leadership Council – 6 plus hours during the months of November through April
4. Advisory Boards- Marin, Alameda, Silicon Valley & Contra Costa- Once a month for two hours.
5. Business Connector Committee- Third Thursday of each month for an hour and a half.
